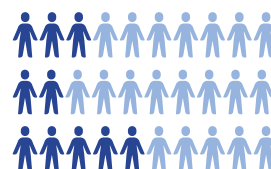

The students that do not speak Portuguese fluently attend **Portuguese Language Learning classes (PLL)**, the ones that want to take an online course as a elective and the ones that want to take a AP or Honors course should participate in this program!

Diploma Requirements, Grading Scale, and Class Ranks

Participation in the Student Service Learning Program (extracurricular and volunteer work) is a graduation requirement. The 80-hour expectation is based upon a student studying at Sant'Anna for four years and is prorated for students entering after grade 9.

Due to the nature of our school and its relatively small class sizes, Sant'Anna does not provide the specific rank of its students. The cumulative GPA of Sant'Anna reflects courses taken at Sant'Anna only. Grades from previous schools are not included. The numerical equivalents used in determining GPA follow NASSP (National Association of Secondary School Principals) guidelines.
